





## **ABOUT THE CAMP**

Raffles American School is one of the premier boarding schools in Malaysia. All our teachers are trained and accredited. The aim of the camp is for students to experience RAS and participate in an intensive English language program that will build upon their current level of English. Class sizes are limited to 17 students per class to ensure individual attention is given to each student. During the camp, students will be introduced to extra-curricular activities such as sports, music, and arts after class.

Boarding students will enjoy living on campus at our state-of-the-art facilities. Activities will be planned in the evenings and on the weekend for these students. While in boarding, all students will be cared for by our dedicated and professional boarding staff. All meals and snacks (3 meals and 2 snacks per day) will be prepared by our school chef to ensure that we only serve a balanced diet of fresh, nutritious foods.

#### **Early Bird Discount:**

Applications submitted before May 1st, 2023 will be entitled to a 1000 MYR discount on camp fees (based on 2 weeks of camp).

#### **Four Week Discount:**

Students that apply for 4 weeks of camp will be eligible for a 5% discount off their camp fee.

### **Sibling Discount:**

Siblings that attend 1 camp or more will be eligible for a 5% discount

English-level tests will be taken online and a schedule will be announced.


